- VISTA stands for 'Volunteers In Service to America'
- Individuals 18 years or older
- Committed to combat poverty through a year of national service
- Create long-term, capacity-building solutions to needs in low-income communities
- Volunteer for limited-length term of service (1 year with option to extend)
- The VISTA program provides the volunteer with a modest living allowance, health care, training, and travel expenses, while you provide them with a meaningful opportunity to build capacity and serve their country
