A third-generation native Washingtonian, Shinar Little started Fog Hill Inc. — a full-service facilities maintenance company — with the intention of providing pathways to good jobs in his neighborhood.

With support from DCAP, Fog Hill Inc., won a facilities contract with Georgetown

University that helped create 60 new jobs, with 90% of them going to DC residents with a starting wage of \$15 per hour.
